

FOCUS: The Worshiper

DAY I: SEARCH ME

DAY III: OVERFLOW IN ME (PART TWO)

PRAY Psalm 119: 164-175. David is worshipping God in those scriptures. He's expressing his love and adoration for the God who provides direction for our lives through His word, laws, commands, statutes, precepts, and decrees. What do you think when you hear these words?

Do you believe if you align your life with God's principles for living (*The Bible*), that your life will be better?

Why do you think David is excited and finds delight in these things? What would it look like for you to delight in the law of the Lord?

Choose one or more of the verses you read and write it on a piece of paper. Tape it to your bathroom mirror as a daily reminder to realign your life.

DAY IV: TRANSFORM ME

Transformation is a process and a journey. It may not happen overnight but if we'll seek to worship Him we WILL be changed. Begin with a time of worship by singing the song From the Inside Out by Hillsong United.
